We are so grateful for such faithful prayer supporters and were encouraged by your many emails.

Craig and I are both fine. Although Craig tested positive for Covid 19, he did not show any symptoms of the virus after the test. We have seen God provide for Craig's safety in his life so many times that we are not surprised, but once again, thankful for His watchful hand over our special guy. I am fine as well and only experienced minor symptoms.

Wayne did end up in the hospital for 4 days with cellulitis. He went back to the doctor on Saturday because he was not responding to the antibiotics. They put him on an IV antibiotic drip and he has been healing. He is home now finishing another series of antibiotics and elevating his leg. He should be pretty well recovered by next week.

South Africa is moving to Level 3 which means that we can exercise anytime during the day, most people are back to work and we are allowed to assemble for church (not over 50). The government is expecting our numbers to greatly increase over the next few months, but cannot keep South Africa in such a strict lock down any longer.

We are looking forward to working next week on the church buildings and deciding as a leadership team how to move forward with services. We want to use wisdom on how to move forward without putting people at unnecessary risk. We are sure you understand.
