I've waited a bit to send another update as there wasn't much to share and as our brother Joachim situation was getting worse by the day. His lungs were completely white except for a very small section (which means that they were all but useless). Three bacterias were reaping havoc and causing his fever to climb. A machine was operating his lungs and the respirator was at 100%.

The doctors suggested that their two kids Lea and Noé come to see him and they started talking with his wife about the day she might have to take the decision to pull the plug.

Friday was a very hard day. Our spirits were so low that the only thing to do was to kneel and cry to God. Timothy, our son, called for a continuous fasting chain (each day at least one person is fasting) and renewed prayers.

Sunday, almost unexpectedly we got news that his situation had stabilized. We loved hearing 'status quo' when we got the evening news (late Sunday night). Muriel, his wife, calls daily after 10am, visits between 3pm and 4.30pm and gives a last call after 11pm. That has become the rhythm of her daysand yours in a way :-)

Yesterday the doctors said that the fever had subsided and that the bacterias were being pushed back. In fact he was never in a state of hyper infection. It seems that the Covid infection peaked later for him than for the other patients. They've been able to reduce the oxygen machine from 100% to 35%.

Mind you, he is still in the induced coma and his situation remains critical but the doctors have said that there is hope. The road will be long but we are making progress on our knees in the right direction.
