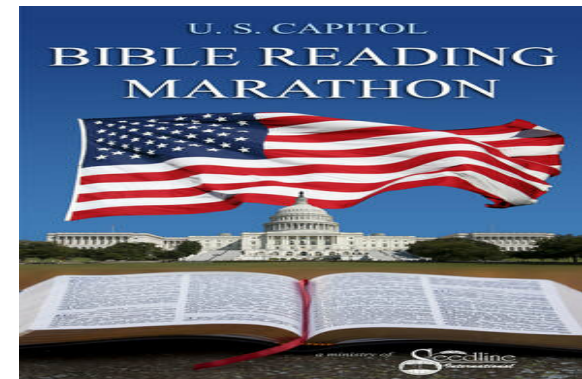

ATTENDANCE

The growth in numbers at the Center has been astounding. We averaged over 30 marines in our Friday night Bible Study every week this month. The last Friday of the month we had 38. We now keep two extra folding tables and a supply of chairs against one wall of the Fellowship area for expansion, and have to set them up every week. All this while we saying goodbye to many of our regulars who are finishing their contracts with the Marines and Navy. More are leaving us in the coming months. New Marines and Corpsmen visit every week, and many become regulars. God is good!

CHAPEL

The Chapel ministry at Camp Johnson keeps growing and those attending keep growing as well. When we took over the Chapel last May, the attendance was around 3 per month. The growth has been amazing. This month our average was 20 per service. Additionally, one of our Navy RP/s (Chaplin Assistants), in school at Johnson, volunteered to lead a worship set each week. Next thing we know, others began offering their service. I was in my local store recently and had a young Marine recognize me. Came up to me, guitar case in his hand and said Mr. Mason, I met at ELR training a few weeks ago and you said you needed musicians at Chapel. I just got my guitar today.
