It is that time of the year here in Cape Town when many go back to the Eastern Cape for holiday. For us, it is a good time to evaluate this past year and the ministries that have taken place. CMI (Church Ministries Institute) went well this year. The three churches (Simanyene, Mfuleni and Happy Valley) met together on Sunday evenings and studied 1st and usually a good time to find a place because people are looking at heading back to the Eastern Cape and will sell their house. It would be wonderful to start off the New Year with a place of our own to hold Bible studies and other ministries. We know the timing is in the Lord's hands.

- While we have this short break this month, we will be visiting families in Happy Valley and trying to start Bible studies. Happy Valley is a mixture of Afrikaans and Xhosa. Please be praying for contacts for us as well as the "Story of Hope" from ABWE to be translated into Afrikaans.
- Visas – Our visas expire in February 2023. We have applied to Home Affairs and are waiting for approval along with 8 other ABWE missionaries here in South Africa.
- Zimbabweans have been told they must leave South Africa. This effects Simanyene Bible Church in Strand. Pastor Admire's family left for Zim this past week and Raison (one of the deacons) his family is leaving in December. These two men plan to join their families in June.
