Four People Groups See "JESUS" Film for First Time

In May four language communities in Gabon experienced the exhilaration of recording the "JESUS" film with CRU technicians. The translation teams persevered over the last four years-even through the extreme challenges of COVID-19-translating Luke and the film's script, struggling to learn lip syncing software, recruiting prayer teams, and finally selecting voice actors and teaching them to read their own language to rehearse their parts.

- That nearly 2,000 people have thus far seen the "JESUS" film. * 75 people have become believers, and many others have recommitted themselves to their Savior.

- That God will continue to transform lives and increase believers' hunger for more of him and his Word.
- For God to energize even more churches to show the "JESUS" film as the teams continue with the translation of Acts, 7-2 Timothy, Titus, and James.

*Worldwide the "JESUS" film has been dubbed into 2000 languages and shown to more than, 70 million people. It is the first and only movie that people groups see in their language, fueling hunger for more of God and His Word. The "JESUS" film encompasses 70 % of the Gospel of Luke so projects often start with Luke's Gospel followed by the "JESUS" film.
