

MISSIONGO –

On March 10th, MissionGO's Board of Directors elected Dennis Campbell—a man who has faithfully served the Lord for nearly 18 years as a missionary and as a senior executive here at our mission—as MGO's 7th President.

Dennis Campbell replaces Dr. Brian Albrecht who announced his upcoming retirement in June 2022.

Over the last nine months, MGO's Search Committee, comprised of select Board members, conducted a presidential search in which they interviewed a number of candidates before unanimously recommending Campbell to the Board.

“Dennis brings a wealth of professional knowledge and passion for worldwide missions to the table and will help to guide MissionGO into the future. I'm pleased the Lord guided Dennis to this position; the mission is in very capable hands,” says Dr. Albrecht.

Matthew Herdzik, the chairman of the Board, remarked, “Our Board is confident Dennis Campbell is the right individual to bring MissionGO into its 80th year and beyond. He has great fervor to take the Good News of Jesus Christ to all nations, and the Board looks forward to seeing what God does through our new MissionGO President.”

Campbell will assume the presidency June 1st. A formal installation ceremony will be held in the summer.

Dennis states, “I am humbled and blessed to take on this new role. I look forward to leading our mission's dedicated staff as we continue to serve and facilitate the North American church who are called to missionary service—doing our part to fulfill our Savior's Great Commission.”

We are excited to welcome him into his new role as President, and we pray God's blessing on him, our missionaries, our staff, and our mission now and in the time to come.
