Dear Praying Friends

Today we are packing and finishing up things to catch our flight this evening to the US. We quickly wanted to touch base before we leave and update you on our family and ministries that we are blessed to be part of here in South Africa.

Praises:

We have purchased the house to renovate into a church in Stellenbosch (Khayamandi)! Two weeks ago, we finished the paperwork and have begun work on the house. There was a lot of clean up and this week walls were taken down, shacks removed off the property, security doors and bars were added and some electric was put into the house. It is now a usable room for the Khayamandi group to meet in on Thursday evenings. They have chairs, Bibles and a white board. The first children's time was held two weeks ago and we had 30 children. The adults average about 12. The young men from the Mfuleni and Happy Valley churches are leading this church.

We held a weekend overnighter for our Jr. High Sunday School class last weekend. We have quite a large house so we were able to accommodate them along with counselors. It was a busy but really good weekend of growing, learning God's Word and sharing the missionary story of Amy Carmichael and lessons learned from her life. Some of the highlights were testimonies from the kids. We believe this type of ministry will work well for us in the future with our church groups and be spiritually profitable and cost effective.

Prayer Requests:

- Visas We are still waiting for our visas to be processed. In the meantime, we are returning to the US and will be able to enter South African again on a 90 day visa. Please pray that our long term visas are issued before the end of the year.
- Please pray for the churches and leaders Mfuleni, Strand, Happy Valley and now Khayamandi as they continue to minister and face the challenges here in South Africa.
- Traveling mercies for us as we depart this evening and especially Craig's welfare.
