Thola Centre/ Camps Abroad/HBC

There has been **silence**, on the **Thola Centre** front. Continue to pray for the hearts of the family whose Grandma sold the property. The current agreement left them until **June 30** to swap properties. That is next Friday. Keep Praying!

Camps Abroad is an organization that travels around the world teaching and equipping locals to run children's camps. We are thrilled they will be joining us this Saturday, June 24-June 29. The first two days are training, last four are camp.

Fifi and I worked with our Soccer Kids and involved them on the theme, they picked "Amaqhwe" (Hero's). The morning sessions will be about four selected OT characters, afternoon sessions will focus on The Son. We are expecting 150+ kids per day, ages 4-14. Mthoko and I will be creating the team attire. Making 200 bandanas, and 8 flags, and purchasing tons of face paint. Then housing two counselors and transporting others each day. Pray for our counselors, as they form bonds and friendships with these little ones. Our desire is to see many of these little ones accept him at a young age so that they could grow in the knowledge of him. Sharing with their friends and family across the valley. We ask for the harvest to be plentiful.

HBC is the South African abbreviation for VBS. We will be serving with Grace Toti the week of July 3- 7th, leading the 4th and 5th graders. We are expecting around 100 kids per day. Most of our teen helpers are the ones I have built relationships with in Sr. Youth on Friday evenings. I am looking forward to having two of my girls as classroom helpers.

The next two weeks will be full of many opportunities. Please ask with us that the Father would provide the stamina necessary to withstand many kids, with many runny noses. I(Abbie) am currently under the weather as I write, please ask the Father to give me the energy needed for the days ahead. We are thankful to put the next foot in front of the other, through unknowns, trials, and scheduled commitments, with hearts of contentment.
