July was a big month for travel for Patty and I. We returned at the first of the month from a church conference in Covington, KY just to turn around the next day to travel to Maryland to see family of the 4th of July holiday. We were back home for a week and then it was off to Latrobe, PA for Patty's family reunion then down to Elkridge, MD to visit the fine folks at Faith Bible Church. When we got home from that, my truck suffered a malfunction in the gas gauge and went into the shop for a week. The city came to the Center for the Fire Inspection (always a good time!) and several emergency counseling sessions with Marines. It was a full month!

Through it all Luke stepped up and really helped us in big ways. He ran the Bible study for us on a night we were out of town, got us prepped for the fire inspection, and did a lot of things behind the scenes that just made life at the Center better for everyone.
