On our way despite the rain and overcast sky a beautiful rainbow boldly emerged, with a second one lightly above it.

I wasn't filled with anxiety about the interview but recognized it was a 50/50 chance. As the rainbow came loudly before us, it was a timely reminder of the Lord's faithfulness to his people. He was faithful to Noah as he sailed on the ark, and he is faithfully guiding and leading his children today. After waiting for 3hrs at the Consulate we received a familiar response: denied. As thoughts of the unknown whirled through my head and tears rolled down my cheeks, we encouraged each other with words of truth. God's timing is perfect and nothing is out of his hand. He is faithful. He is trustworthy. Nothing can separate us from his love. In sadness and discouragement and many emotions of the heart, it is a lifeline to look at the character of God. He is Holy, and everything he allows is for his children's good, to glory of His Name.
