As we continue to press on with ministries and studies we ask that you would join us in lifting up the items below. Particularly wisdom on our vehicle. In February, I wrote about our beloved "lemon," and it's multitude of issues. Tomorrow morning we have appointments with two dealerships.

The first is to see the car we are interested in and talk with them regarding pricing. It is a 2018 solid 4x4 good for unmaintained dirt roads, and rivers we drive on regularly. It is listed for R419,000 (\$22K). The second appointment is with the dealer who sold me(Abbie) the car in 2021.

We have asked them for the proper information to restamp the missing engine number and they are dodging the request. Instead they have asked us to bring it in for a quote to buy back the vehicle. In this country we often have road blocks where police check the vehicles due to the amount of stolen vehicles, forged paperwork, and poor maintenance. If we are stopped without an engine number, our vehicle could be seized and we would lose any remaining value.

By God's grace so far, I(Abbie) have been able to charm the police by the few Zulu words I know, then they do not fully inspect the vehicle, but this novelty could run out at any given time. Currently we have \$4K and the value of our vehicle to go towards this need. So, we bring this need before you, asking you to pray for provision. Thank you for your faithfulness to us thus far, we are grateful. Pray with us for wisdom as we trust in God's provision.
