Greetings fellow brothers and sisters in Christ!

We pray that you are well. I want to thank you for constantly praying for us as we go about our daily schedule and activities in the children's home, and various ministries. On September 19, we flew back to Texas to go on deputation and raise support for various projects to enhance the children's home. Ligaya and I also have doctor's appointments we must attend to. We ask you to please pray for God's provision and for traveling mercies.

ask that you pray for this trip of ours as we try to present the need of Solar Panels for the children's home. Every month, we pay \$2,000 for our electricity bill. It is a large sum of money we could use for other necessities. The solar panels will generate power/electricity for the children's home. We had several solar companies give us figures. We are praying for \$120,000 which is what it will cost. We know that this is a big number, but we serve a bigger God. We are asking you to please pray that God sees fit and will provide.

For the year 2023, we rescued 2 children from the streets. One is a child of a former US Marine now living a dreary life. Unfortunately, the child that we rescued ran away and went back to the streets since he was already a teenager and was already fond of the street life. The father has attended two Sunday services, and we pray that the church will help him see his need of salvation and will come to repentance. We are so thankful that God allows us to cater to more souls as it is indeed a growing crisis in the Philippines that is obviously something we must act upon. Considering their disheartening situation, we would like to thank you for allowing God to use you in partnership in the ministry.

On September 4, we started our school year at Subic Bay Bible Institute with 6 new enrollees. I am teaching pastoral lectures on Tuesday nights. We are hoping to get well-equipped pastors and a pastor's wife who is willing to serve full-time in the ministry. Please pray that these students will press on and finish the course.
