Our older students who have moderate to mild intellectual disabilities are part of our sewing class. This year they are making quilts, potholders, bags, table runners and pillows. These items are part of our fundraising efforts and it is going very well. They do need assistance, but are making some beautiful things and are leading productive lives.

We had such a wonderful day at the center when Siyabonga received his new wheelchair! We have waited for two years for a new chair from the government and nothing. Siyabonga's feet were on the floor since he is now 18 years old and is quite tall. Thank you for giving so we could purchase this chair for him! Siyabonga uses his eyes as a mouse on the computer and his chin to drive wheelchair. He is able to take his chair back and forth from home to center and has that independence. Siyabonga is in the process of learning excel so he can assist us with bookkeeping at the center next year.

Many of our little ones have cerebral palsy and need 1:1 assistance in everything they do. We take joy in the small accomplishments made!
