# Prayer Requests:

**Visa Situation** – It has been over a year that we have been waiting for our Visas along with many other missionaries. After December 31<sup>st</sup>, we will not be able to leave the country unless this situation changes. We would be declared "undesirables" and not be allowed re-entry into the country again for several years. We do have a few possibilities: 1).Our visas would be processed before December 31<sup>st</sup>. 2) A letter of extension from Home Affairs giving more time for them to process our visas or 3) leave South Africa for at least a week and re-enter on a 90 day Visa. The last one seems most likely, but expensive. Please pray for our Visa situation.

<u>Building projects</u> – We have many projects coming up in 2024! Between the 3 churches and 3 ministries for those with disabilities, and the new

church plant in Stellenbosch, we are busy 💛 and have a lot of building needs.
