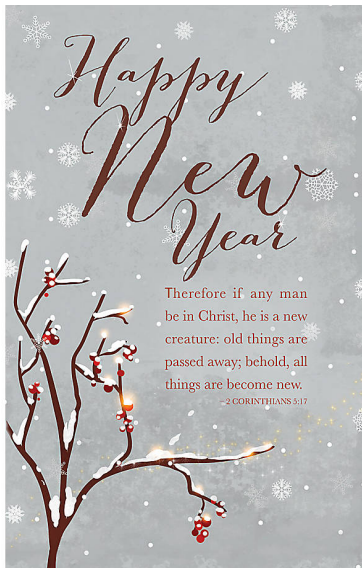

Our second thing is an upcoming trip to Guatemala. It seems unlikely I will be able to go. I was hospitalized for a complicated UTI, Flu and Pneumonia. I am recovering but it is slow. The brothers going down have been before and I know them and believe God will use them mightily. They will be working out of our main church in Xejuyup with Ben Tahay and his brother in Pacanal Dos. Pray for them. We have other trips planned for 2024 and hope you will consider a mission trip their too.
