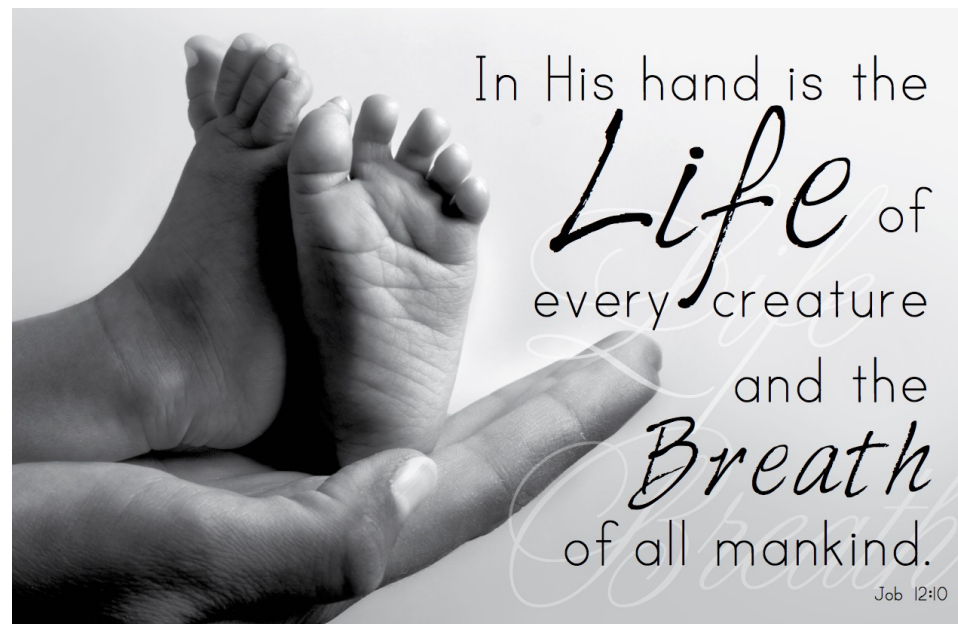

During Thanksgiving, Ligaya and I were able to be in East Texas where I grew up. It was a nice time spent with two of our children and several of our grandkids. We returned here to the Philippines as soon as we wrapped up our medical checkups and a few remaining speaking engagements. As soon as we got back we were hit with one event after another. We were so blessed to see God's hand move through wonderful people who provided Christmas gifts for the children, a beautiful meal and Christmas bonus for each of our staff and workers of Subic bay Children's Home. It is amazing how generous God's people are!

Another answered prayer most definitely worthy of praise is that of our Solar electricity system. I will often just sit and marvel how God miraculously provided that need. The contractor is working on installing and setting up this new electric system. We look forward to see a drastic change in our monthly bill.

I may have mentioned Johnrine in past newsletters. Johnrine was taken into our home at 6 years old. He is now 23 and has been on staff since 2017. He was abandoned by his parents at birth but God took him up! He is a godly young man now who has graduated from his four year course of Animal husbandry and Agriculture. He continued his studies in our bible Institute and is in his 3rd year and will be graduating soon. He has many responsibilities in the children's home. He manages our livelihood farm where he trains our young boys to work the farm. He is also a houseparent and also foreman of our field workers. On weekends Johnrine and another one of our Pastors travel by boat to a remote Island where we have a mission work and hold bible studies and Sunday morning service. It is a prayer of ours to be able to bring Johnrine to the US with us as we travel around. He would be a tremendous blessing to us as he would assist me (Teddy) in driving, as it is getting very difficult for me to drive with intense pain on my right leg as soon as I start to drive. The greatest blessing though is for him to be able to share his testimony with you, our supporters, and here how God has used you to help change and transform lives to be of great service to God!
