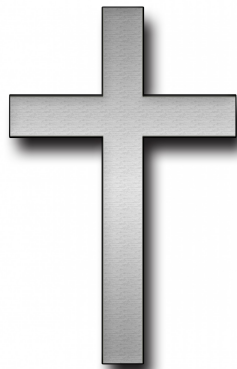

During school holidays we are looking forward to hosting our second year of camp!

We are overjoyed at the multitude of good works the Lord has given us to do, as we make his name known among the Zulu people. We pray that the Lord would soften the hearts and the hearers of His word. That they would turn from their wicked ways, and know Him alone as their Lord and Savior!

Pray for Mthoko, as I am gone he is left with the load of two. He has been faithfully filling in my gap physically to make sure supplies are available to keep our ministries going. The Lord has blessed me with a hardworking husband, I am thankful.
