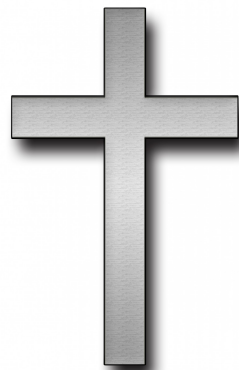

Dear Praying Friends,

We had our first winter storm here in Cape Town and the winds were incredible! We felt a little bit like Job on Sunday morning as one call after another told us of the disaster that this storm had done.

The first call told us of fires that were spread to the shacks in Khayamandi Stellenbosch burning down over 30 shacks. Sixteen of our Sunday School families were affected and three of them (that we know of) lost everything. Thankfully there were no injuries that we are aware of.

The second call came from our new residential home. The security fence around the premises had blown down. Then another call came saying that the wall landed on our Quantum transport vehicle and all the windows are smashed out on the driver's side. After that came a call saying the carport roof was in the neighbor's yard.

Praises:

\*Our church buildings were not affected by the storm.

\* Our Cape Caring Fund is helping us to purchase food parcels, blankets, clothing and other things as some of the families were not able to get anything out of their shacks.

Simanyene Bible Church of Strand held an HBT (Holiday Bible Time) last week and 10 young people trusted in Christ.

\*We had 12 people who were baptized last week on Resurrection Sunday"

Thank you for praying for the funding from DSD (Dept. of Social Development). They will continue this year to fund a portion of the operating expenses for Simanyene Center for the Disabled.

Prayer Requests:

\*Ministering to the families in Khayamandi with food and clothing but also sharing the gospel and showing that we as a church love and care about them spiritually as well. Please pray for wisdom for us in the distribution of these food packages. It can easily become a riot in such an impoverished township and difficult circumstances.

\*Repair and clean up at the new residential home.

\*Spiritual growth for the new believers in Christ.

Thank you for partnering with us. Your prayers and support make all the difference in reaching these people for Christ.
