LARGE CROWDS

We are having a record-setting attendances at the Center...in February! We are consistently over 25 and at times mid 30's on Tuesdays and we are hitting the 40's on Friday's. The crowds are frankly getting too big for regular services each week. Our building gets very loud very quick with this many in attendance. Plus, since there is little room, after the service many just head out quickly and we don't have the opportunity to sit down and talk one-on-one with many of our regulars and first-time guests. It's a good problem to have, but it has us thinking about a change.

BUILDING

The large crowds inside also present a problem outside. When a church service has 40+ in attendance there are usually less than 20 cars in the lot, since families drive together. When we have 40+... We have 40+ cars! This has led to our guys parking on the street, come nearly a quarter mile away because there is precious little on street parking with other residents in the neighborhood. Plus, our neighborhood is a dangerous, run down area of the city. One of our Sailors was approached on a recent Friday night as he got out of his car and was asked if he would drive someone a few blocks away to pick up some drugs. Putting all of these situations together we have decided to start looking for another building to meet in. We are praying God directs us to another church building in the area where we can "swap" buildings with another church, or take over a building from a church that may soon close their doors (there are a few in the area that fit this bill). If not, that we could sell our building and have the funds to purchase a warehouse or other commercial building that we could get into and renovate. Please pray with us about this "good problem to have."

We had to say goodbye to Michael this month. He has been with us for a little over 2 years. He is being moved to Marine Corps Air Station Iwakuni, Japan. On his last night we had our coin ceremony and Mike encouraged everyone at the center to be more faithful.
