With care and humility, we wish to share a heartfelt update regarding two of the beloved children of our home—Jericoh and Chris Albert (Totoy). We ask for your prayers and continued support as they go through this time of illness and recovery.

Jericoh, one of the dear children entrusted to our care, has been confined in the hospital for the past three days. His medical team has recommended that he be seen by a specialist to gain a deeper understanding of his condition. In the meantime, adjustments have been made to his treatment plan, including a higher dosage of antibiotics and a stronger nebulizing solution. We are currently waiting for further updates from his doctor tomorrow. As we remain in hope, we entrust Jericoh to the healing hands of our Lord, believing in His mercy and provision.

Chris Albert (Totoy), another cherished child of our home, is showing signs of recovery. We are thankful to share that the bleeding from his stitches has ceased, and he is no longer experiencing fever. He has regained his appetite and is now able to eat well. However, he is still experiencing facial swelling and pain in his head and face. He has been prescribed pain relievers to be taken every six hours, along with a course of antibiotics for the next seven days. We continue to pray for his comfort, strength, and full healing. In times like these, we are reminded of the power of prayer and the importance of lifting one another up in faith. We humbly ask you to join us in praying for Jericoh and Totoy—for their complete healing, for wisdom and clarity for their doctors, and for peace and strength for those caring for them. May our loving Father surround them with His grace and restore them fully in His perfect time.

Thank you for standing with us, for your compassion, and for being part of this home where love and faith are lived out daily.
