Over the last few months, when I have been facing challenging physical issues, I have become so aware that no matter what we are going through "God is enough!"

As I have been sick and pretty much housebound since May, I have found myself asking God, "How can I do anything for You when I'm so confined in this body and house?" It's been amazing how God has answered that question, and I have found a new passion for reaching others for the Lord. It started out with my physical therapist and home health care nurse who actually came to me here at home. Then since I've been so sick, every week I was finding myself at labs, doctor's offices, clinics, etc. interacting with numerous new people. Then I was back in the hospital again with so many different people to witness to: nurses, doctors, housekeeping, dieticians, and so on.

I was meditating one day on Paul when he was in prison in Rome- the guards were constantly chained to him, changing on every shift- he used the opportunity for ministry. He said, "I am in bonds to Christ (not Rome)." That spoke directly to my heart. I am in bonds to this broken body, not because of illness but for opportunities to reach out to others. The times I've had with all these medical employees has been incredible and what a change of perspective as to why I can't get well! My heart has been filled with amazing joy to suffer through the hard times for a bigger purpose. May I be found faithful every day.

As some of you may know, I have four compression fractures in my spine. Lying flat on my back every day has become quite a chore. I am unable to move without being lifted by my son-in-law, my grandson and my son with the rest of my care being given by the girls in the family. I have now been placed in hospice care and am suffering great pain. I would appreciate your prayers for God's grace with is sufficient for all of our needs. He truly is enough.
