Dear Pastor Lowther & Saints of Camp Springs Community Church

May our Lord God be praised for His faithfulness. You continue to encourage us with your expressions of care and help; we thank you so much for your prayers and/or financial support which continues to be needed as we still work on getting resettled into the parsonage. This has been a challenging summer for us because we have had to endure heat temperatures and humidity much higher than what we had back in Australia; our bodies have struggled with this change. Constantly running the air-conditioner is not something to which we are accustomed and our bodies have had trouble adjusting to it while not having much fresh air. However, we have enjoyed the daylight-saving time which we had missed for a long time in Australia.

Please continue to 'lift us up' in prayer. We both recently have semi-recovered from a virus that 'knocked us back' for over 2 weeks; it may have been Covid, but we are not sure. Ron is still having Physical Therapy sessions several times a week and will continue doing this for another month hoping this helps to alleviate the severe sciatica pain in his right leg while sitting in a car for over 45 minutes. Recently he also had to see a 'foot doctor' due to ongoing considerable pain in his right foot and right ankle. The foot doctor said it is Plantar Fasciitis in the foot, but a worse problem is with an extremely tight tendon in his right ankle. For about an hour a day, the foot doctor has him wearing a special foot boot that is designed to stretch the tendon in his ankle to try and alleviate the intense pain while walking at times. These health issues are inhibiting us from doing any extended travel; we trust you understand. Despite these aging health problems, the LORD is so good to us.

We thank you for all you have done for us, and we praise the Lord for your faithfulness. We continue to pray daily that God will bless you and reward you eternally for all you have done for Him, our ministry and for us.
