WORLD MISSIONS UPDATE FOR 28 MARCH 2021

HOME MISSIONS

NEW LIFE BIBLE CAMP

1. The camp has added a 16 year old Tennessee walker horse named *Zing* to its small herd of riding horses.
2. Project Elevate to expand their dorm facilities to 100 campers has reached \$111,795, which is 56% of the \$200,000 goal.
3. Camping runs from June 21 through August 6 with Soccer Camp, Mountain Top Weeks, Horse Weeks, & Water Weeks.

AMERICAN CENTER FOR LAW & JUSTICE

1. The Fifth Circuit ruled that Texas, Louisiana, & Mississippi can exclude Plan Parenthood from state Medicaid programs.
2. The University of Vermont Medical Center began performing abortions without announcing this decision to the staff. Several nurses who morally object to participate in termination procedures have been scheduled to assist in them. After reaching out to ACLJ, the issue has been referred to the Department of Justice.
3. A county in California denied a Messianic Jewish congregation land use permits which it allowed other non-religious charities to use under similar circumstances. After sending a letter to the county that they were in violation of the Religious Land Use and Institutionalized Persons Act, the county reversed course and allowed the congregation to use the land.
4. The Sixth Circuit overruled a District Court decision to block a new Tennessee law which bans abortions in the case of discrimination due to health, race, or gender considerations or in the case of a detectable heartbeat. The state can now enforce the new law.

FOREIGN MISSIONS

TEAMS FOR MEDICAL MISSIONS (JOHN + LINDA HEATER)

1. The mission was looking for a place for their new missionaries, the Kauffmans, to rent on a month to month basis.
2. 5 doors down from the TEAMS house a man had rooms for rent. When approached, the man told them that he had dedicated the house to the Lord and would rather sell the house outright to the mission. So, T4MM has signed a contract to purchase this lovely 7 bedroom/6 bathroom home for \$200,000. The Team board has put up \$25,000 of their own personal money toward the purchase. They need to raise the rest of the \$175,000 by August, so they can go to settlement in September.

THE PHILIPPINES (JUNE & VANGIE MANGAYA)

1. Even though the pandemic has shut down many in person ministry, the outreach goes on. June baptized 17 new converts in the river while onlookers stopped to watch.
2. June's youngest, Fidel, was among those who were baptized. Vangie had led him to the Lord.
