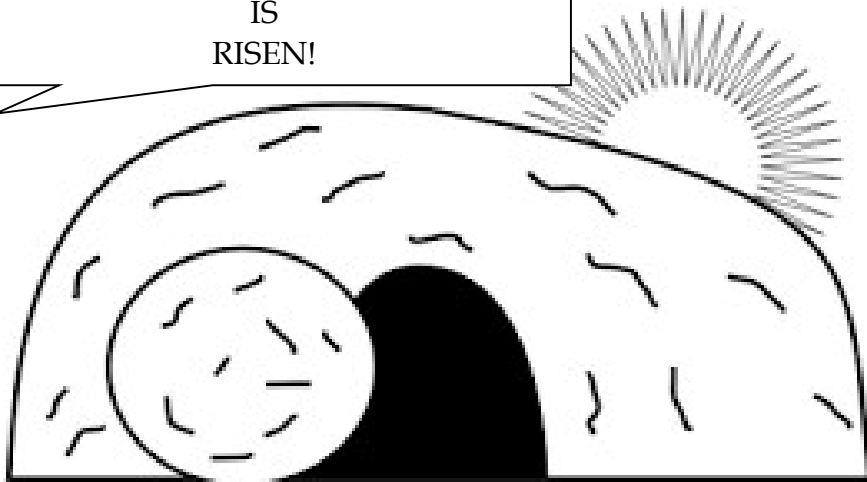

Have you ever prayed for years for something you believed the Lord wanted for you, and knowing He wanted it for you, you persisted faithfully in prayer believing He would one day answer that prayer with a resounding YES?

God just answered our prayer for more property in Jamaica with a resounding YES! But the timing was completely unexpected.

We were looking for a place to rent a room for our new missionaries, the Kauffmans, for a month at a time, every 3 months – with the hopes that as that need extended, so would the opportunity to rent. We approached a homeowner 5 lots down from TEAMS House as we heard he had rooms available in his home. He agreed to rent a room to us, but he said he would rather sell the property to us! He told us that in his will he had designated this house as the Lord's house and that he wanted a ministry to own it and use it for ministry in this community.

Long story short, he is selling to us this fully furnished, 7 bedroom, 6 bathroom lovely home, sitting on an acre of land with the same view of the sea as TEAMS House for \$200,000 USD. We are going to settlement in September of this year and need to raise the full amount by August (just 5½ months from now). T4MM's Board of Directors believes this is a gift from God that we should accept and pursue and have personally donated \$25,000 to get us started! But we can't do this on our own – please consider joining us in this endeavor.

WORLD MISSIONS UPDATE FOR 04/04/2021

IFCA MISSIONS REPORT

1. Pastor Clegguart Mitchell of South County Bible Church (St.

Louis) & 3 others led 2 Bible conferences in the Republic of the Congo. This is an area of the world where Christians have had their houses & Bibles burned & their cattle stolen. They delivered 400 Bibles to believers in the 1st conference at Minembwe, where there are 80,000 persecuted believers. 375 pastors attended the 1st conference & 275 the second. 800 Bibles were handed out at a crusade where over 400 people prayed to receive Christ as savior. Two years ago they were working with 3 churches & now they are working with 150. The team hopes to return to the area on 3 Sept.

2. Henkhothang Tungnung of Zo Christian Bible Church in Manipur, India reports that churches are starting to meet in person again as mandatory lockdown procedures are eased. In one village a chief donated land worth \$4,000 in Khupgou Village. A new church building is being constructed there.

At Asian Games village in Imphal, the church could not pay their loan on a church plot. They need \$5,000, of which Zo Christian Bible Church is trying to raise \$2,000 from local churches. They are asking that other churches in the fellowship raise the additional \$3,000 to pay off the loan.

3. Midwest Church Extension announced that they will need a new church plant leader for Summit Bible Church near Chicago. Micah & Lanna Windle will be leaving the work in May after 5 years at the church plant. They Church plant has a bilingual profile.

The Church Extension program is looking for church planting recruits to be trained in their Residency Program.
