

WORLD MISSIONS UPDATE FOR 4/11/2021

WAYNE & SUE ROYCE (SOUTH AFRICA)

- 1. At the annual business meeting at the Mfuleni Bible Church, Tisetso was voted in as their pastor by an unanimous vote. Both Tisetso & his wife, Zikhona, are doing a wonderful job.**
- 2. The Mfuleni & Happy Valley Churches came together for a special Easter service & meal. Happy Valley Church also distributed food packages to their Sunday School class children, which was funded by Good Hope Caring Fund.**
- 3. After the Royce's bakkie (truck) was stolen, found, & then returned, the truck is finally back on the road after 8 months, having passed the required government re-inspection & tagging of the vehicle.**
- 4. Renovation of the Mfuleni house has begun. They have combined 2 bedrooms to make a classroom for the Junior High Sunday School class and the CMI Sunday evening ladies's meeting. 7 young people have declared their faith in Christ this month.**
- 5. The Simanyene Center & Residential Home are doing well. The Residential Home is now full with 12 residents. The center is now fully open 5 days/week with 20 learners.**
- 6. The Royces are seeking help to expand the Happy Valley Church space to accommodate their worship services & 2 Sunday School classes. If they receive enough funds, they would like to finish the outside walls and roof before the winter rains arrive.**
- 7. Holiday Bible Time (akin to VBS) is scheduled for the end of April for the Simanyene & Mfuleni churches. Pray that the children will respond in faith to the Word of God.**
