

A Bagaga pastor named Mr. Yulius wondered *How* can Jesus know and love me enough to die in my place—yet he doesn't speak my *language*?

That all changed one Easter Sunday. The service began as usual, but then Mr. Yulius noticed a familiar sound filling the air as the preacher began his sermon. The preacher was reading God's Word in Bagaga, his heart language—the language he uses to pray, sing, and share jokes.

Afterwards, Mr. Yulius was overwhelmed with wonder and gratefulness: "Thank you!" he shared. "This translation project has helped build the capacity of a local pastor. This not only helps the community but is also an advantage for the church."

## MISSIONS UPDATE (Apr 18, 2021)

### FREDDIE & JUVI MANZANOS (PHILIPPINES)

1. They have 20 candidates for baptism (May 21)
2. Need \$4,000 to replace the church ceiling, both inside & out. Temperatures during services run around 118°F.

### TEAMS FOR MEDICAL MISSIONS

1. Due to the pandemic there have been 5 J-Team to Jamaica canceled this past year. Since tourism is Jamaica's main industry, the people are in dire condition and the J-Teams are unable to help at this time.
2. Ministry has changed to personal involvement by the on site missionaries, the Kauffmans, as they work to distribute food, build cultural connections, distribute medical supplies where needed, and host student teams visiting to help with the ministry.
3. Kali Hentzel, daughter of Randy Hentzel, who was murdered in Jamaica 3 years ago, led a long term YWAM team to help in the ministry. Staying for 6 weeks, they painted, built the backyard patio & basketball court to host meetings & outreach events at the J-House, built a home for a mother of 6, and distributed food.
4. The Kauffmans and Steaven Vassell now host a young men's basketball outreach event at the J-Team House every Sunday evening.
5. J-Teams is raising money to buy a house on the same block as the J-Team house for \$200,000 to host ministry teams. This 7 bedroom, 6 bathroom will go a long way to furthering the ministry. About half the money has been raised, but the rest needs to be raised by the end of August.
