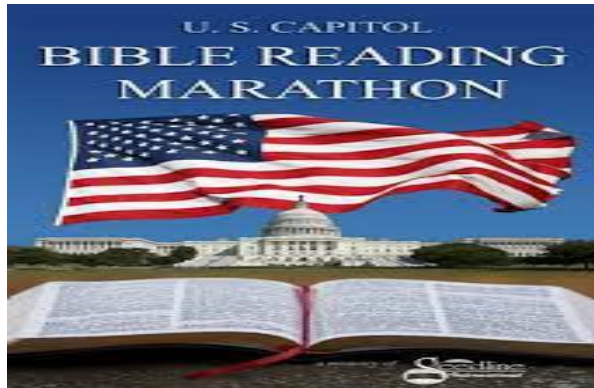

Nathaniel, Maddie, Annie & Alex are able to homeschool in a classroom with children their ages. This is a HUGE answer to Prayer!!! Please pray for this school year. Our Children have the opportunity to stand up for their faith, and we have the chance to be a witness to those around us. (Many believe in the prosperity gospel or have let family superstitions & forms of "traditional" religion influence their view of God and the Bible.)

I have also been able to bake for a few church events and am slowly enjoying cooking again. OH! I also drove myself and a friend to Kampala and back last week. Now that I can travel without Matt, look out Uganda! ☺

Enough about what I have been up to, let's see what Matt's been up to. When we first got back, he fixed the things that broke while gone (or right after getting back). He is working with a few university students to fix up a room for a widow and her children to live in at church. So far he has hung the ceiling board, plugged the leaks in the roof, and will be painting the inside soon. He also visited with friends and pastors locally and out at the Bible College. The Lord kept him safe through all of his travels. Matt will be teaching a community Health Evangelism class in a few weeks out near the Bible College. Please pray for him as he prepares to teach a 5-day class and share with this rural church and community.

We are SO blessed to have you in our lives. Thank you for praying for us, for supporting us, for encouraging us. Our ministry overseas couldn't happen without you!
